IPSWICH HOSPITAL COMMUNITY CHOIR

Ipswich Hospital Community Choir is a friendly group of people of all ages and backgrounds who come together for the pure pleasure of singing. We are not a formal choral society, rather a very relaxed and fun group. We rehearse weekly on Wednesday evenings, and perform at a variety of events during the year.

The choir is led by Nick Coleman, our Musical Director, who also arranges many of the pieces of music we sing. We have an active committee consisting of representatives from each section; also, an Events Co-ordinator, Membership Secretary, and Website Support, as well as the Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.

Repertoire: We sing a variety of pop and show songs as well as some classical pieces. Our ever-expanding repertoire includes What Was I Made For, Les Miserables Medley, Rhythm of Life, Somewhere Only We Know, Supertrouper, as well as some well-known classics such as Downtown, Sing and Georgie Girl. Our arrangements are sung in SATB (soprano/alto/tenor/bass) harmony, with occasional solo parts included in the arrangements.

Rehearsal times/venue: Rehearsals take place each Wednesday in the Courtyard Restaurant at Ipswich Hospital from 6:15 to 8:15 pm. There is no audition to become a member, nor any requirement to be able to read music. Before you commit to joining, the first two sessions are free. If you are unsure of your singing range, Nick will guide you to the right section. Or you can try different sections to see which works best for you.

Parking: Parking is available on the hospital site free of charge; you will need to ensure we have your registration number at each trial session or rehearsal so we can inform the car parking company to exempt the charge.

Fees: The current fees are £36 for 3 months membership, which is payable via standing order on a quarterly basis. You will pay pro-rata for the quarter in which you join.

Choir Clothing: Once you become a member, you will need to purchase some clothing items in order to take part in performances; further details will be provided once you have joined. You will also need a black folder to keep your scores in when attending a performance.
